Online giving is not replacing any of the traditional ways we already give, but is an additional option to those who prefer to make their donations by computer, cell phone or other mobile devices. College Street is using a church donation system provided by the Easy Tithe corporation. *EasyTithe* is church specific and is currently used by hundreds of churches across the nation.

You can make a regularly scheduled contribution or you can specify recurring donations. You can specify whether the contribution should go to the general budget or to designated categories. A credit card (MasterCard, Visa, or Discover) or a debit card can be used as well as a regular checking account. The process is secure and confidential and you will have continual access to your giving records.

Please mark your church calendars and make plans to be a part of our upcoming **Church Revitalization & Replanting Conference** (November 3-4, 2019) at Seneca Baptist Church. While everyone is invited to attend I would especially encourage all Pastors, Church Staff Ministers, Deacons and all key Lay Leaders to attend. **Jim Breeden** serves as the Executive Director of Missions for the St. Louis Metro Association in St. Louis, MO. Since coming to St. Louis Metro in 2000, Jim has focused on strengthening churches. Jim has over 30 years experience in both revitalizing and replanting churches. The passion of his life is to see churches revitalized and replanted.

**Bob Bickford** is the Replant Pastor of The Groves Church, founder of churchreplanters.com and the Associate Director of Replant for the North American Mission Board. Bob also serves as the Chair of the Church Revitalization Team of the St. Louis Metro Baptist Association. He is the author of "Am I A Replanter?" as well as the "Associational Replanting Guide" that is used by the North American Mission Board. Bob lives in Webster Groves, MO.

**Randy Schuler**, serves as Pastor of the Chesterfield Community Church in Missouri. Randy has served the Chesterfield Community Church for over 20 years and has seen consistent growth. He is currently leading the church in a major building expansion. He will be speaking on issues related to the revitalization of a church.
