

Another amazing Christmas season is behind us, not the least of which was our "One Night at Christmas" dinner theater experience. What an incredible difference our new acoustical panels made! Many thanks to all who helped make that possible.

Even though I'm already enjoying a briefly lighter schedule for January...

Now's the time to think about those former choir members or potential new recruits who need to be part of what we're doing.

I call it "Jubilant January" (I know, slightly cheesy). This will entail brief rehearsals, with familiar, 1 rehearsal anthems. The idea is to expose former and new people to a stress-free choir experience, in the hopes of adding to our musical community.
