# Sleep in Heavenly Peace Bed Build

At our February meeting of Golden Fellowship, we were blessed to have as our guest speaker, Kaitlyn Turner, president of the Westminster chapter of Sleep in Heavenly Peace. What we learned that night moved everyone in attendance. After the meeting was over, we knew something had to be done. The issue was too important to ignore, and our Golden Fellowship members are too caring to sit idly by.

What we learned that night caught us all by surprise, as we really had no idea of this terrible problem that is literally right under our noses. The problem is children, Oconee County children, sleeping on the floor every night because they do not have a bed to sleep in. Something as simple as a bed with soft sheets, a fluffy mattress. and a pillow, not being available to every child in our community just left us heartbroken. Kaitlyn shared some staggering numbers with us that night. Right now, they currently have over 330 applications for beds for children (ages 3-17) who do not have one. That number is just for children who live in Oconee County! That is unimaginable! Sleep in Heavenly Peace is a 501-c3 organization that relies solely on the kindness of others to work towards the goal of their motto, "No kid sleeps on the floor in our town". We want to help. The cost of 1 bed is \$250, which covers the wood and hardware to construct the bed, a mattress, a sheet/comforter set, and a pillow. The beds are paid for by donations, and volunteers along with a few SHP builders build the beds at what is called a "Bed Build" event.

These events are planned when they have a group or organization who will partner with SHP and provide the money and volunteers to help build the beds. There is a minimum of 10 beds needed to host a Bed Build, which means to host a Bed Build at College Street Baptist Church, we would need to raise \$2500. Also, we would need a good number of volunteers who could help on "build" day. With the faith to believe God is going to provide, Kaitlyn has agreed to schedule a Bed Build Day to be held at College Street Baptist Church for Saturday, June 21st. A line item has been put in our budget for donations toward this event. Donations can be placed in an offering envelope with the designation "Sleep in Heavenly Peace." If donating by check, please make checks payable to College Street Baptist Church. If we get more than \$2500 total, and we believe we will, we can build more beds that day! It's going to be a wonderful event and will bless so many local children who presently sleep on the floor every night. Please pray about how you can help. We need donations now and volunteers on that day. Also, you can volunteer to help deliver the beds with a SHP team member after the build. All tools and materials will be provided, along with a few SHP builders to oversee the bed construction. No building experience is needed. There will be something for everyone to do on that day. Let's do this, because "No kid sleeps on the floor in our town"!


